Presuming You Want to Write a Blog Post One blog post is composed of an introduction which includes a thesis statement for your paper. In-text citations can be included but aren't required for this introductory section. In the introduction, your reader needs to understand your topic, so provide a thesis with a short abstract. The abstract includes a few sentences that describe the topic for which you are writing. The focus of your post is what you will talk about in this specific article, so focus on the subject that is most interesting to you and your readers. For example: "This paper will discuss how to increase traffic around buildings." The abstract can be up to about 100 words in length, but keep it concise and general enough so that it can easily be rewritten when describing each section of your document. A thesis statement or argument is also very important in this section of the document. Try to sum up the main idea of each paragraph so that it is easy for the reader to understand. For example: "According to statistics, 15% of people want to drive around buildings so they can enjoy their views." The next part of the introduction talks about the purpose of this document. Explain why you are writing this article and what is most important that readers should know after reading this specific work. Use an informative, interesting or provocative introduction that will pique readers' interest. After the introduction, write a body section that emphasizes your thesis statement and the idea you want to prove. Keep in mind that if you use direct quotations, you need to write them as citations and make sure that you always provide the page number where these citations can be found. These citations should also be located at the end of your work; put all works cited together and label each one as such. Emphasize the main idea (your thesis) by providing evidence or examples for this section. You may also use anecdotes or biographies as evidence for your work; however, do not use only personal experiences as this may not be considered professional enough. For example: "...Some people like the idea of having buildings surround them because it makes them feel like they are in a private world."
